Program Structure

Internship duration: **one semester**

Modalities: **hybrid**. Online and on-campus in Tempe (Fulton Center, across University Drive from the SILC building); schedule to be adapted to the intern's academic schedule.

Available to **1 student** at Arizona State University's School of International Letters and Cultures.

Students commit to **45-135 hours in total**.

This internship does not offer compensation.

Interns will be eligible for **1 to 3 academic** credits through ASU's School of International Languages and Cultures.

Roles and responsibilities

Development:

- Facilitating the identification of potential partners within ASU and establishing connections with CY Cergy Paris University.

- Exploring opportunities for collaboration with support organizations outside of the primary partners (companies and institutions).
- Researching existing collaboration models and programs (including international grants) that could bolster the partnership's objectives.

Communication:

- Supporting the marketing efforts of the Partnership within and beyond the three organizations.
- Contributing to the cultivation and upkeep of relationships with stakeholders.

Special Projects:

- Undertaking designated special projects as assigned by the leadership of the partnership.
